

Golf/ATV Permits

The Erie City Council voted to allow operation of Work-Site Utility Vehicles, Micro Utility Trucks, All Terrain Vehicles and Golf Carts on the Streets within the Corporate Limits of the City of Erie. These rules and regulations will be enforced as followed:

1. All vehicles must be present during registration. The City will inspect the vehicle and place the registration sticker.
2. ATV/Golf Carts must be registered by Dec. 31 each year to be registered for the following year.
3. Golf carts are not required to have insurance, but will be required to have a slow moving placard on the back.
4. ATV's will be required to have insurance. Headlights and taillight will not be mandatory unless driven after dark.
5. Fee for registration will be \$10.00 and registration sticker must be placed on the vehicle.
6. All Golf Carts/ATV's must be registered to drive on city streets.
7. Golf Carts/ATV's will not be allowed on State Street. However these vehicles are permitted to cross State at 90 degree **ONLY**.
8. Golf Cart /ATV will not be allowed on 4th Street from 59 HWY to Main Street. However these vehicles are permitted to cross 4th Street at 90 degree **ONLY**.
9. All operators of Golf Carts/ATV's must have a valid driver's license.
10. All operators and/or passengers under the age of 18 must wear a **DOT** approved helmet.
11. All operators shall ride only upon the permanent and regular seat, there for such operator shall not carry any person on the vehicle. In which event the passenger may ride upon the permanent and regular seat if designed for two.
12. **Violators will lose their city registration for one year after receiving two citations.**
13. **Absolutely no driving or riding on the sidewalks at any time.**

Penalty:

Pursuant to Ordinance No.2009-884

Unless specifically provided for herein, a violation of this section shall be deemed an ordinance traffic infraction. Upon an entry of plea of guilty or no contest or upon being convicted of such violation, the penalty imposed shall be in accordance with Section 201,2008 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, or such other similar provision as the city may then have in effect.

(a) If any operator is cited and convicted of two or more separated violations during a calendar year then the City of Erie will revoke operator's registration.
